# Quiz: Education in the UK

## Answers:

1. Answer: False. According to Eurostat, the UK has a university dropout rate of around 6%, while countries like Spain and Portugal have rates exceeding 30%.
2. Answer: False. The UK spends less per student on primary and secondary education compared to the OECD average. In 2018, the UK spent \$9,800 per student, compared to the OECD average of \$11,300.
